National Children's Center (NCC) Early Learning Center and Early Intervention Center

- Eligibility: Children ages 8 weeks-5 years old. For Pre-K3, the child must be 3 years old by September 30. For Pre-K4 the child must be 4 years old by September 30. Children with and without disabilities are enrolled in an inclusive educational setting. Financially eligible families can apply for a voucher onsite to cover full or partial cost of childcare.
