By registering for any PokerStars Open events, you confirm that you are not banned from PokerStars online or live events. Players found to be in violation of this policy will be disqualified and forfeit their buy-in.

EVENT DETAILS:

- 1. Players start with 40,000 in tournament chips.
- 2. Levels change every 40 minutes on Day 1. 60 minutes on Day 2
- 3. Re-entries take priority over alternates. Alternates have 10 minutes to re-enter.
- 4. Late registrtion and re-entries are allowed until the start off level 13. No refund.
- 5.A single ante will be paid from the Big Blind for the entire table. The ante is posted prior to the Bia Blind.
- 6. Day 2 is Sunday, April 27th at 11:15 AM and will play to a winner.
- 7.1 in 8 entries will be in the money. Day 1's conclude once 12.5% reamin.
- 8. Any player eliminated on Day 1 will not be in the money. Players must bag chips to make Day 2.
- 9. Players are permitted to register and play multiple Day 1 flights.
- 10. Players qualifying for Day 2 may play another Day 1 flight in an attempt to better their chip
- 11. Players that have qualified for Day 2 with multiple chips stacks will only be permitted to play their highest qualifying stack. The other stacks will be taken and removed from olay and the olayer will receive the minimum Day 2 payout for each stack.
- 12. Dinner break on Day 2 will be determined by the Tournament Director.
- 13. Players may forfeit their stacks at the end of registration to re-enter.
- 14. Re-draw will take place at 27 player if there is more than 80 entries and final table of 9.
- 15.\$960 from each entrant goes to the prize pool, \$110 is registration fee and \$12 goes towards staffing fee.
- 16. All promotional and Satellite seat winners's stacks will be in play at the start of the flight they registered.

HOUSE RULES:

- 1. Must be 21 years of age or older to play.
- 2.A Live! rewards© card is required for tournament registration and at the tables.
- 3. Live! Casino and Hotel will follow most TDA Rules, any exceptions will be announced.
- 4. Players start with a full stack. Purchased stacks wil be put into play at the end of registration if player is still absent. Play begins with 4 players checked in.
- 5. Winnings over \$5,000 must have a valid I.D.
- 6. Any unauthorized chips introduced into tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution. Any parties determined to be responsible for the introduction of said chips will be disqualified without refund. It is each and every player's responsibility to bring to our attention unusual chips, circumstances or irregularties.
- 7.Live! Casino and Hotel will not be held responsible in the event of typographic errors or misinformation on Bravo, Websites or printed materials, and players will have no claim to these matter.
- 8. Tournament prize pool may be modified if all remaining players unanimously agree and the agreement satisfies the rules outlined.
