EVENT DETAILS:

1. Players start with 30,000 in tournament chips.
2. Day 1, levels change every 25 minutes. Day 2, levels change every 40 minutes.
3. Re-entries take priority over alternates. Alternates have 10 minutes to re-enter.
4. Late registration and re-entries are allowed until the start of level 11. No refund.
5. A single ante will be paid from the Big Blind for the entire table. The ante is posted prior to the Big Blind.
6. **Day 2 is Sunday, May 18th at 12:15 PM and will play to a winner at Live! Maryland!**
7. 1 in 8 entries will be in the money. Day 1 conclude once 5% remains.
8. Players are permitted to register and play multiple Day 1 flights. Players must bag chips to be in the money.
9. Players qualifying for Day 2 may play another Day 1 flight in an attempt to better thier chip count.
10. Players that have qualified for Day 2 with multiple chip stacks will only be permitted to play their highest qualifying stack. The other stacks will be taken and removed from play and the player will receive the minimum Day 2 payout for each stack taken out of play.
11. Re-draw will take place at 27 players and at the final table of 9.
12. \$512 from each entrant goes to the prize pool, \$61 is registration fee and \$24 goes towards staffing fee. \$3 is for the Tournament of Champion Leaderboard.
13. Day 1 Payouts will be \$1,300 (Day 2 minimum cash determined once registration closes.)
14. Day 2 starting blind level will roll back to the earliest Day 1 completion time or level 15, whichever is greater.
15. All playeres who advanced to Day 2 will receive a minimum of 5 TOC points. Players who register in Philadelphia and make the final table will receive an additional 10 TOC points. TOC promotions are property specific.
16. All Satellite seat winners' stacks will be in play at the start of the flight they registered.
17. Tournament may be adjusted to play 10 handed.

HOUSE RULES:

1. Must be 21 years of age or older to play.
2. A Live! rewards© card is required for tournament registration and at the tables.
3. Live! Casino and Hotel will follow most TDA Rules, any exceptions will be announced.
4. Players start with a full stack. Purchased stacks will be put into play at the end of registration if player is still absent. Play begins with 4 players checked in.
5. Winnings over \$5,000 must have a valid I.D.
6. Any unauthorized chips introduced into tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution. Any parties determined to be responsible for the introduction of said chips will be disqualified without refund. It is each and every player's responsibility to bring to our attention unusual chips, circumstances or irregularities.
7. Live! Casino and Hotel will not be held responsible in the event of typographic errors or misinformation on Bravo, Websites or printed materials, and players will have no claim to these matter.
8. Tournament prize pool may be modified if all remaining players unanimously agree and the agreement satisfies the rules outlined.
9. Management reserves the right to change or cancel any tournament. On-site PGCB will be notified of any cancelations on any tournament.
10. Tournament Director's decisions are final and without recourse.
11. Discourteous behavior and abusive language towards players or the team will not be tolerated.
