Midi Baccarat

Baccarat is played with eight decks of cards. The cards are shuffled and placed in a dealing “shoe.” The object of the game is to bet on the hand with a final point total closest to 9. All numbered cards two through nine count as face value. Other cards (jack, queen, king and ten) count as 0 and aces count as 1. For example, a seven and queen draw has point total of 7 while an ace and three counts as 4. Any two cards which total 10 (ex: six & four) count as 0. Cards which add up to more than 10 will count as the number over 10 (ex: eight & seven count as 5).

Betting decisions are based on how much you want to bet on the hand of the banker or the player. Wagers can be made any time before “no more bets” is announced by the dealer. You may also bet that these two hands will end in equal totals or tie. To begin the game, four cards are dealt alternately from the shoe.

In Midi Baccarat, the dealer will draw four cards from the shoe face down with his / her left hand. The first and third card shall represent the player’s hand. The second and fourth cards drawn shall represent the banker’s hand. The individual with the highest Player wager has the option to receive and handle the cards for that round of play including any third card when needed. The same rules apply for the individual with the highest Banker Wager. If the point count of either hand is 8 or 9, it is called a “natural” and no additional cards are drawn. The drawing of a third card, if necessary, is dictated by strict rules depicted in the accompanying tables.

In no event shall more than one additional card be dealt to either hand. Providing the banker’s hand does not have a natural, the player’s hand draws a third card first. Thereafter, the banker’s hand is completed according to the table. If both hands end in equal totals, it is a tie and neither hand wins or loses.

All bets on players’ hands are paid 1 to 1 except on a separate tie bet, which pays 8 to 1. The house will collect a 5% commission or vigorish on all money won on the banker’s hand.

RULES FOR DRAWING ADDITIONAL CARDS PLAYER

When first two cards total:

1 – 2 – 3 – 4 – 5 – 0	Draws
6 – 7	Stand
8 – 9	Natural—Stands

BANKER

When the player stands on 6 or 7, the banker will always draw on totals of 0, 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5, and stand on 6, 7, 8 and 9. When the player does not have a natural, the banker shall always draw on the totals of 0, 1 or 2 and then observe the following rules:

BASICS OF DRAGON BONUS

Dragon Bonus® is an optional wager for baccarat that pays when your hand is a natural winner or wins by a large margin. The highest payout is for a non-natural that wins by nine points.

GETTING STARTED

Make the Dragon Bonus wager by betting in the marked area. You may bet the Dragon Bonus wager for the Player, the Banker or you may bet them both. Philadelphia Live! does require you to make a standard baccarat wager.

WINNING AND LOSING

You have two ways to win:

- 1) When your hand is a natural winner
- 2) When your non-natural hand wins by at least four points

OVERVIEW

Royal 9 adds a bonus element to traditional baccarat where each player has a unique K9 hand printed at the seat they choose, if the player wagers on the bonus and completes any posted hand, the player is paid according to the posted pay tables.

BEGIN PLAY

- Players wager on the traditional baccarat wagers. In addition they may place a wager on the optional Royal 9 Bonus Bet.
- The dealer will then deal and settle traditional baccarat wagers, before settling the optional bets.
 - If any player has made a Royal 9 posted hand then they will be awarded the payout.

HAND DEFINITIONS

Personal K9 vs. Personal K9	Player and Banker hands match the K9 combination designated at the player's seat.
Banker Personal K9	Banker's hand matches the K9 combination designated at the player's seat.
Player Personal K9	Player's hand matches the K9 combination designated at the player's seat.
Other Personal K9 vs. Identical K9	Player and Banker hands match a K9 combination designated at any other seat.
Suited Royal 9 vs. Stuffed Royal 9	Player and Banker both have a suited Royal 9. The two Royal 9s don't need to match in rank.
Royal 9 vs. Royal 9	Player and Banker both have a Royal 9. The Royal 9s don't need to match in rank or suit.
Any Suited Royal 9	First two cards are a face card and a 9 & suited.
Royal 9	First two cards are any faces card with a 9.

MUST HIT PROGRESSIVE

The MUST HIT progressive is awarded randomly, starts at \$100 and must hit by \$500.

5 **TREASURES** **BACCARAT**

BASICS OF 5 TREASURES

5 Treasures Baccarat™ is played the same way as traditional baccarat without modifying any of the existing drawing rules of the standard game.

Treasures Baccarat™ offers four separate optional bonus wagers and one that will cover all four of the bonus wagers.

GETTING STARTED

Make your standard baccarat wager. You may also make any one (or all) of the bonus wagers by placing your bet/s in the marked area. Once all bets have been placed, the dealer will draw cards and all standard house baccarat rules are followed.

WINNING AND LOSING

Once all cards have been dealt and the baccarat outcome is known, the dealer will resolve the standard baccarat wager along with any bonus wagers you have made.

FORTUNE 7

The Fortune 7 bonus wager wins if the Banker's hand wins with a 3-card total of 7.

GOLDEN 8

The golden 8 bonus wager wins if the Player's hand wins with a 3-card total of 8.

HEAVENLY 9

The Heavenly 9 bonus wager wins if the Banker's and/or Player's final outcome is a 3-card total of 9.

BLAZING 7'S

The Blazing 7's bonus wager wins if the Player and Banker's final outcome is either a 2-card total of 7 or a 3-card total of 7.

COVER ALL

Place a Cover All wager and if any one of the separate bonus wagers win, you win.

See the posted pay table for all bonus wager odds.

FORTUNE 7

Outcome	Pays
Banker Wins with a 3-Card 7	40 to 1

GOLDEN 8

Outcome	Pays
Player Wins with a 3-Card 8	25 to 1

HEAVENLY 9

Outcome	Pays
Player and Banker have 3-Card 9	75 to 1
Player or Banker have 3-Card 9	10 to 1

BLAZING 7's

Outcome	Pays
Player and Banker have 3-Card 7's	200 to 1
Player and Banker have 2-Card 7's	50 to 1

COVER ALL

Outcome	Pays
Any Winning Event from Above Side Bets	6 to 1
