During the negotiations for the 2014 Basic Agreement and FLTTA, the DGA discussed its concerns regarding the geographic scope of the Basic Agreement. Following negotiations, the parties will establish a Geographic Scope Committee for the purpose of discussing issues related to work performed by non-U.S. resident Directors outside the United States and Canada on theatrical motion pictures with the Committee to meet no later than October 1, 2014. The Employers also agree to conduct individual company meetings at the request of the DGA, with such meetings to occur within a reasonable time after the DGA's request and to be attended by the president of production and/or senior executives who are responsible for the selection of Directors employed on theatrical motion pictures and senior labor relations executives.
