The Nature of the Assurance

This is a report by SLR Consulting Limited (SLR) for Ian Hagg, Director of Responsible Business, DLA Piper International LLP.

SLR has undertaken a limited assurance of the ESG Metrics section (non-environmental data sets) of DLA Piper's ESG Data Tables 2024-2025, found in the ESG Metrics section of DLA Piper's ESG Databook for the reporting period 1 May 2024 - 30 April 2025 against the GRI Principles of Accuracy, Clarity, Timeliness, and Verifiability.

DLA Piper International LLP is entirely and solely responsible for the production and publication of the data assured, SLR for its assurance.

This engagement was performed in accordance with the International Standard on Assurance Engagement (ISAE) 3000 (Assurance Engagements other than Audits or Reviews of Historical Financial Information).

SLR has complied with the requirements for independence, professional ethics and quality control as stipulated by ISAE 3000 (2020) Requirements 3a and 3b.

Assurance work performed

The assurance work was commissioned in May 2026 and was completed on 23 September 2025. Detailed records were kept of meetings and correspondence relating to the assurance. A team of three, led by Bolu Iyiola, Managing Consultant, undertook the assurance and commentary process. An assurance expert acted as adviser to the group.

The assurance engagement was undertaken to a **limited** level and involved the following activities:

- Interviews with 6 issue owners covering the full range of topics reported on.
- Follow-up questions arising from the issue owner interviews.
- A review of requested supporting evidence and specific data sets within the ESG Data Tables 2024-2025.
- A review of the definitions used for some of the basis of preparation and notes.

Independence

During the reporting period, our work with DLA Piper focused exclusively on assurance.

Based on the scope of work and assurance procedures performed, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe the non-environmental data sets as listed in the pages of ESG Data Tables 2024-2025 is not prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with the GRI Principles of Accuracy, Clarity, Comparability, Timeliness and Verifiability.
