Artificial Intelligence

Data, Privacy, and Cybersecurity

Intellectual Property

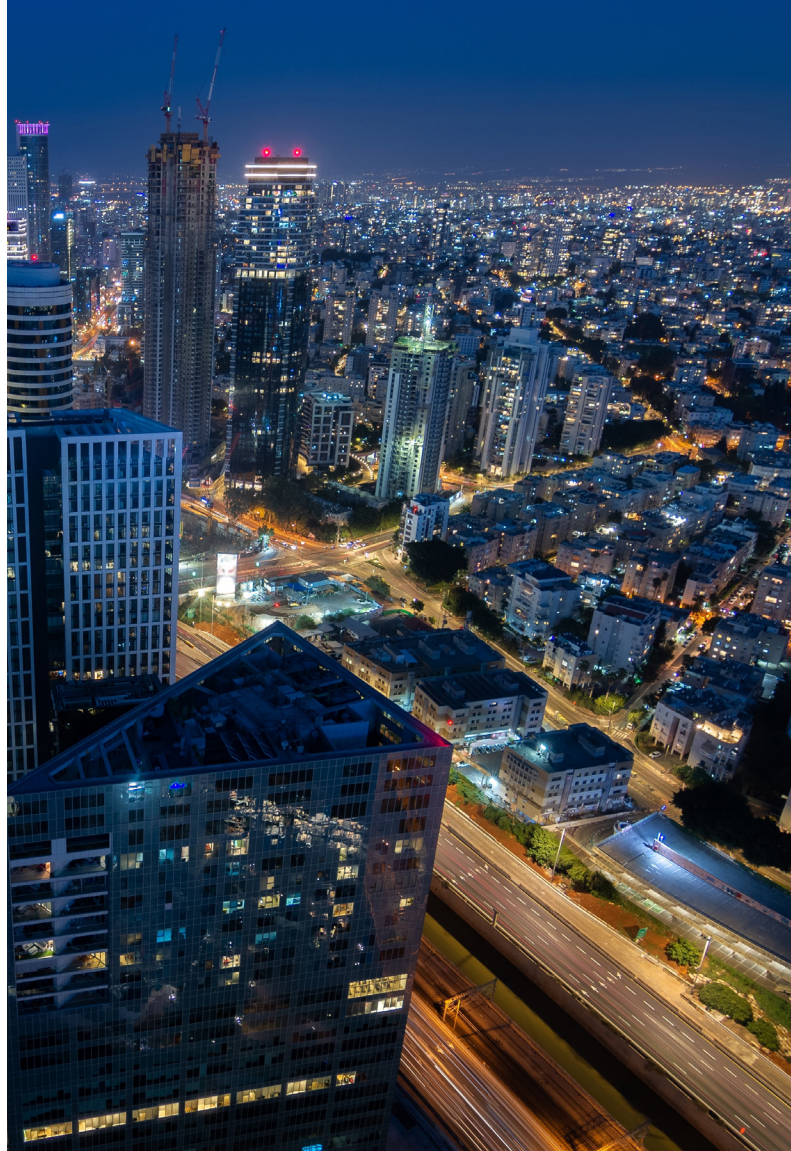

National Security and Global Trade

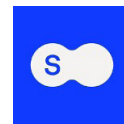
Real Estate
