Documents required for registration and qualification review for becoming a DIFC Registrar of Companies approved audit firm

- 1. Complete 'Fit & Proper' application form.
- 2. Details of the background and history of the auditor.
- 3. Details of ownership, details of other companies in the group and resources available at hand.
- 4. Details of professional indemnity insurance which can provide cover in respect of the work undertaken for DIFC non-regulated entities.
- 5. Statement on the credentials, capacity and resources of auditor.
- 6. Copy Of Ministry of Economy Auditor's Certificate
- 7. Fees is \$500

Note: The above does not apply to auditors who are currently registered with DFSA as auditors.
