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PFAC Purpose, Membership, and Structure

<u>Purpose</u>: Provide a forum that enables patients and family members to have direct input into the development of policies, programs and practices at Braintree Rehabilitation Hospital.

<u>Recruitment</u>: Members are recruited via staff recommendations and Annual Patient Recognition Ceremony.

<u>Selection of Members / Election of Officers</u>: Interested members complete an application; they are then interviewed by PFAC members. New PFAC members must also complete the volunteer orientation process and a successful TB and CORI background check. Officers are nominated by PFAC members. Current co-chair is a former patient. Administrative / Staff Liaison Co-Chair: Director Case Management.

<u>Term of Service</u>: PFAC members serve a minimum of a one year term with a preference for a 2 year term. PFAC co-chairs will serve a minimum 2 year term.

<u>Current Structure/Design</u>: 2014/2015 PFAC consists of 7 former patients/family and 1 BRH staff member. The current Co-Chairs are a BRH staff representative and a former patient. Active recruitment is on-going for new members. Meetings occur on a quarterly basis or more often as the committee requests to meet. Each meeting has a well organized agenda with standing items of facility and state quality care measures along with facility initiatives brought forth by PFAC Committee members, ongoing PI teams, Patient/Family Satisfaction Suvery results, etc.

Minutes are taken and reviewed each meeting for needed follow-up items. An annual report is shared with the Governing Body. This annual report is available to patients, the general public, and the Massachusetts Department of Public Health on BRH's website at www.braintreerehabhospital.com

Orientation and Continuing Education
