

Reinforcing compliance to SDI 120 – Testing and Commissioning for Distribution Systems

31 March 2023

Following our recent stop & reset for safety, we wanted to reinforce the requirement of SDI 120 for the testing and commissioning of distribution systems. As a reminder, it is a requirement of SDI 120 that appropriate tests have been completed competently by ASP1s and have achieved the minimum requirements for the equipment being commissioned.

Importantly, the test results must be received by Endeavour Energy Construction Coordinator's [prior to commissioning](#). The Construction Coordinator may request to witness test the results if they are not satisfied that the tests have been conducted appropriately.

To support this process, we have updated the ASP Forms template to remove FPJ2017, FPJ2016 and FPJ4260 which are obsolete. The new version of the ASP Forms template is available under *Forms and Procedures > ASP Level 1* on our [ASP Portal](#), along with the relevant SDI 120 tables, in an editable PDF format. Please ensure you are using the new version of the ASP Forms template and the relevant SDI 120 tables for your projects going forward.

We also acknowledge that there continues to be a large paperwork burden for ASP1s in our process. With this in mind, we have commenced a broader review of all ASP1 forms with the intent of reducing this paperwork burden and finding improvements on our data collection process. We will communicate more on this following our review.
