Pre-Commissioning Tests and Checks

Due to the recent period of protective industrial action, several projects were left incomplete, and work at certain locations has been on hold for an extended period. Multiple reports have identified issues such as unfinished works, equipment still awaiting commissioning, vandalism, asset theft, and some projects exceeding the acceptable testing timelines. These delays and issues pose a significant safety risk, including potential electrical exposure to both workers and the public.

As we resume work on these projects, it is essential to conduct all necessary pre-commissioning tests and checks to ensure safety. If equipment has not been commissioned within four weeks of completing pre-commissioning tests, the tests will need to be repeated prior to commissioning.
