- 2. How you see the applicant's potential and future in Australian academic medicine or medical research arena?
- 3. Where you would place the applicant with respect to the relevant peer group?
- 4. Is there any particular work that has already been done which would make the applicant worthy of this award?
- 5. Your assessment of (or your views on) the quality of the research proposal.
- 6. Questions for applicants at interview.

Referees' reports are treated as strictly confidential and will be available only to members of the Medical Advisory Board and the Secretariat.
