


# INHERITANCE GUIDE

## QUEENSLAND

This is a guide to who will inherit an Estate, under Queensland law, if a valid Will is not left. It is a guide only and specific advice should be obtained in relation to individual circumstances.





## DEFINITIONS

**Spouse** means

- a. The person to whom you are married at the time of your death
- b. Your de facto partner at the time of your death
- c. Your registered partner at the time of your death

**Registered partner** means the person who, at the time of your death, is in a registered relationship with you within the meaning of the Relationships Act 2008.

**De facto partner** means a person (other than a registered domestic partner) who, although not married to you is:

- Living with you at the time of your death as a couple on a genuine domestic basis (irrespective of gender)
- Either
  - Had lived with you in that manner continuously for a period of at least two years immediately prior to your death
  - The parent of your child who is under the age of 18 years at the date of your death.
