1. You feel your project aligns with our focus areas, I encourage you to submit your application on SmartyGrants. or
2. You are ineligible to apply - You are also welcome to introduce it to us through our 'Say Hello' [form](#).. It's a simple way to share your idea and should take less than ten minutes to complete.

- Yes you are still eligible to apply, subject to a satisfactory acquittal report (needs to be submitted prior to application in order to be considered)
