

Data Privacy Information

Your personal data is collected by our local security department (EHS-SEC), represented in Dresden, which manages the access data and the allocation of authorisations for our locations in Germany. These are:

GlobalFoundries Dresden Module One LLC & Co. KG / GlobalFoundries Dresden Module Two LLC & Co. KG / GlobalFoundries Management Services LLC & Co. KG - in each case: Wilschdorfer Landstraße 101, 01109 Dresden and GlobalFoundries Europe Ltd., Zweigniederlassung Deutschland, St.-Martin-Straße 64, 81541 München („GlobalFoundries“).

The data collection and processing is based on Art.6 par.1 lit b. and lit f. GDPR. The data is used to check the application for access, to issue the badge, to check export restrictions in accordance with the legal requirements in the EU and the USA and to assign and administrate the requested authorisations. These include, but are not limited to: access to the premises and access to rooms; the carrying of objects on the company premises (e.g. own laptops); parking on the GlobalFoundries site; the right to access the clean room; the right to take photographs on the company site.

The basic data as well as the assigned authorizations are managed in a central database which is only accessible to a limited number of persons from our security department 'EHS-SEC'.

It operates at the respective GlobalFoundries sites, including our sites in the USA (GlobalFoundries U.S. Inc.) and Singapore (GlobalFoundries Singapore Pte. Ltd.).

We ensure that the data can only be used by authorized persons and for the intended purpose by means of measures such as access restrictions in the system, instruction on the confidential and purpose-related handling of the data as well as the conclusion of data protection agreements (EU standard agreement) between our business units.

Only the following data will be stored in our central database:

- Last name, first name, nationality, date of birth, gender
- Information of the current employer (company name, company address, job title, Subcontractor for another company),
- Vehicle information (manufacturer, model, license plate number),
- Emergency contact (details are voluntary information),
- Name of the responsible sponsor, access period and access areas,
- Authorizations for the transport of GlobalFoundries property,
- Assigned permissions (see examples as mentioned above).

Other data of the Contractor Application form will not be stored in our central database. The completed Contractor Application form will be stored in files, locally and access restricted, by our department 'EHS-SEC' and will be securely destroyed in accordance with the defined data retention period after inactivity of the contractor.

Explanatory notes concerning the use of the data:

1	Identification of the contractor-employee; master data administration at GlobalFoundries; export control check
2	Identification of the contractual partner/contractor company; master data administration at GlobalFoundries
3	Registration for the parking permit on the company site or for the designated parking spaces
4	Information on an optional basis / For prompt contacting of relatives in the event of an accident at work or other preventive measures taken by GlobalFoundries to protect the person concerned.
5	Confirmation of the correctness of the information provided
6	Confirmation of knowledge and recognition of compliance with the GlobalFoundries guidelines
