The following information regarding the processing of personal data ("Information"), concerns all persons who register at the construction site ("Construction Site") NTT Project – FRA5, Heddingheimer Straße 22

65795 Hattersheim am Main.

With this Information we would like to inform you about how we process your personal data ("Personal Data"), what rights you have as data subject, and provide you with other helpful material about data processing.

There may be circumstances under which we process your Personal Data differently from what is outlined in this document. For example:

- As our employee,
- through use of our IT Systems (such as DMCS),
- as customers / clients, suppliers, other business partners and interested party, e.g. for invoicing etc.
- as a visitor to our website.

The same applies, in case we may have to process your Personal Data in case of special circumstance, e.g. police investigation.

In those circumstances we may provide separate data protection information as required.

Additional data processing information includes but is not limited to

- As business partner, personnel of a client, supplier, contractor or other party under the following <u>Link</u>, wherein Exyte Central Europe GmbH is the controller.
- Data processing on our website under the following <u>Link</u>.
- As an employee of Exyte you can find further information in OneNet.

Please note that if you are working for a client or contractor, supplier etc. ("Business Partner"), the Business Partner may process your Personal Data independent from Exyte, including while you are on the Construction Site. Furthermore, our client may have additional security measures or other processing activities in certain areas, which are under the sole control of the client and where the client is controller of your Personal Data. Please refer to the business partner or the client for further information, including your rights regarding such Personal Data.

This information may be updated from time to time. You will always find the newest version, at the entrance to the Construction Site or at the Guard House.



If we refer to "you" as reader of the Information, we assume that you are the "Data Subject" whose Personal Data we process.



4) Source of the Personal Data

Personal Data is typically collected from you directly (e.g. through forms), the Hammertech Database System, the Guards, through the gates when entering our Construction Site, with a badge or on site when recording incidents.

5) Transfer of Personal Data

We generally do not share Personal Data with third parties. In individual cases, photos or other documentation may be passed on to the customer or contractor for construction site documentation. The legal basis is Art. 6 Sec. I Lit f GDPR with the legitimate interest in documenting and organizing the construction site.

Furthermore, we may share names, e-mail, company, entry and exit data and other data with our contract partners including the client, if that is required for us to comply or prove compliance with our contract, including ancillary contractual obligations, as well as for the protection of our customer's legitimate interests or to verify account statements based on Art. 6 Sect I f GDPR, whereas it is our legitimate interest, as well as the legitimate interest of our contract partners, to comply with the contract or to verify account statements or invoices as well as the security of property, including intellectual property, and that of the contractual partners and customers and their personnel (e.g. to ward off industrial espionage). In cases where our client is subject to Authority audits, it is the client's legitimate interest to support Authorities in conducting their legal duty and ours to support our client in complying with the law.

We may share all data named above with Customs Authorities to protect against tax and social security evasion, and illegal work, based on Art 6 Sect I Lit c) GDPR i.c.w. § 5 Abs 1 S. 1 SchwarzArbG, § 2, 3, 4 and 5 SchwarzArbG. See also the processing activities above.



In addition, we may share your personal data with Authorities, where required, to receive special services or permissions, e.g. work on Sundays or holidays (e.g. §15 ArbZG), whereas we provide the information based on our and your company's legitimate interest to receive such special permissions.

We engage service providers for technical infrastructure and software (e.g. cloud providers) to store data for us. We conclude processing agreements and / or non-disclosure agreements with such service providers to safeguard your data. These service providers are only permitted to process Personal Data for us for the purpose they are engaged.

We may transfer Personal Data between Exyte affiliates within the Exyte Group based on our legitimate interest according to Art. 6 para. I lit. f GDPR or other legal reasons, where they apply, whereas our legitimate interest is to organize Exyte Group centrally and provide services, within group service centers, as well as to have the processing allocated to the most suitable Group member for further interaction with the data subject.

All Exyte Group members are subject to a Data Protection Policy to ensure a constant level of data protection.

Some Exyte Group members may be located outside the European Economic Area ("EEA") in countries for which the European Commission ("EC") did not decide that such countries provide an adequate level of data protection.

All Exyte Group members therefore signed a Data Processing and Joint Controller Agreement ("DPJCA") which includes the standard contractual clauses as approved by the EC to safeguard the processing of Personal Data outside the EEA, i.e. all Exyte Group members are contractually obligated to comply with an adequate data protection level.

We also use Processors, which are bound by contract to process personal data subject to our instructions. Some of the processors are also located outside the EEA. If there is no adequacy decision by the EC for these third countries, we have safeguards in place. Generally we rely on the standard contractual clauses as approved by the EC. In some cases sub-processors are subject to corporate binding rules in accordance with the GDPR or other safeguards in accordance with Art 46 GDPR. In individual cases we may rely on exceptions in accordance with article 49 GDPR.

Transfer of Personal Data to third parties outside the Exyte Group may also take place in the following cases:

- Transfer with your express permission (Art 6 para. I lit a GDPR or Art 9 para II Lit a GDPR);
- Transfers to third parties to which we are legally obliged, for example to the tax office or other governmental authorities, according to Art. 6 para I lit c GDPR, Art 9 para II lit b or lit h) GDPR;



- Transfers to third parties to fulfill our commercial and tax obligations, for example to our tax auditor according to Art. 6 para I c GDPR i.c.m with the respective individual obligation, if we are legally obliged to transfer such data or Article 6 para I f GDPR, if the transfer is not mandatory, but required for our legitimate interest to efficiently communicate and proceed with authorities and comply with our obligations.
- To conduct or assist with investigations into breach of laws or compliance regulations, assert legal claims or to defend against legal claims we may transfer data to authorities or to lawyers, agents, experts etc. based on Art. 6 para I lit f GDPR, whereas it is our legitimate interest to assert or defend from legal claims. In case of special categories of Personal Data we may transfer such data based on Art. 9 para II lit f GDPR to assert or defend against a legal claim.

Any transfer of data to a third country outside the EU, which is also not a party to the EEA, will only take place subject to requirements in compliance with the GDPR. We will provide you with a copy of these standard contractual clauses upon request.

If you require any further information about transfers or safeguards, please contact the DPO.

6) Duration of processing

Unless expressly stated otherwise herein, we will process your Personal Data for only the time which is necessary to complete the purpose for which it was collected.

We may, however, have to retain your Personal Data for longer in case of legal obligations (e.g. a tax audit), or to defend or assert a legal dispute. We may also delete Personal Data earlier, if legally feasible and practical.

7) No automated decision making

We do not base decisions which have legal implications for you solely on automated decision making, such as profiling.

8) Your rights

Upon request, we will inform you whether Exyte processes any Personal Data about you, and if so, the nature of such Personal Data.

You have the right to object to the processing of your Personal Data for advertising purposes. If you object to the processing for purposes of advertising, your Personal Data will no longer be processed for this purpose.

To object to the processing of personal data for advertising purposes, you may do so by emailing info@exyte.net. However, we accept any other form of objections to advertisement, which allows us to clearly identify you.

Furthermore, based on your particular situation, you have the right to object to processing of your Personal Data which is processed based on Article 6 para. I lit. f GDPR, i.e. legitimate interest, or Art 6



para. I lit e GDPR, i.e. processing based on necessity for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest, or in the exercise of official authority vested in Exyte. In case you object to processing based on the aforementioned legal basis due to your particular situation, we will only continue to process the information if there are compelling legitimate grounds to process your Personal Data which override your interest, rights, or freedoms to stop processing your Personal Data, or for the exercise or defense of legal claims. This also applies to profiling based on the aforementioned.

Under the conditions as set out in the GDPR, according to Art. 16 GDPR, you also have the right to correct your incorrect or incomplete Personal Data, as well as a right to deletion according to Art. 17 GDPR and a right to restrict the processing of your Personal Data under Art. 18 GDPR.

You have the right to have us provide you with the Personal Data you have submitted to us, in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format. You have the right to transmit (or have transmitted) the Personal Data to another controller (Art 20 GDPR).

If the processing of your Personal Data is based on your consent, you have the right to revoke your consent at any time. The lawfulness of the processing prior to the revocation of consent is not affected.

You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority for data protection matters. Unless stated otherwise, the competent authority is the Landesbeauftragte für Datenschutz und Informationsfreiheit Baden-Württemberg.

As data subject you can also contact the authority responsible for the Construction Site location.
