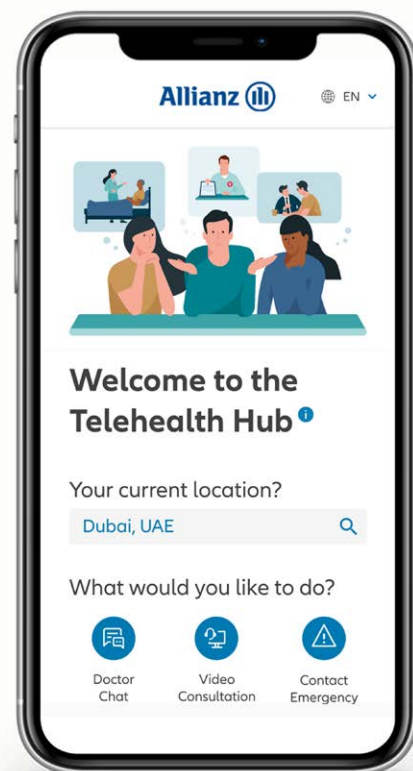

Click on "Health Assistant" and then TeleHealth Hub

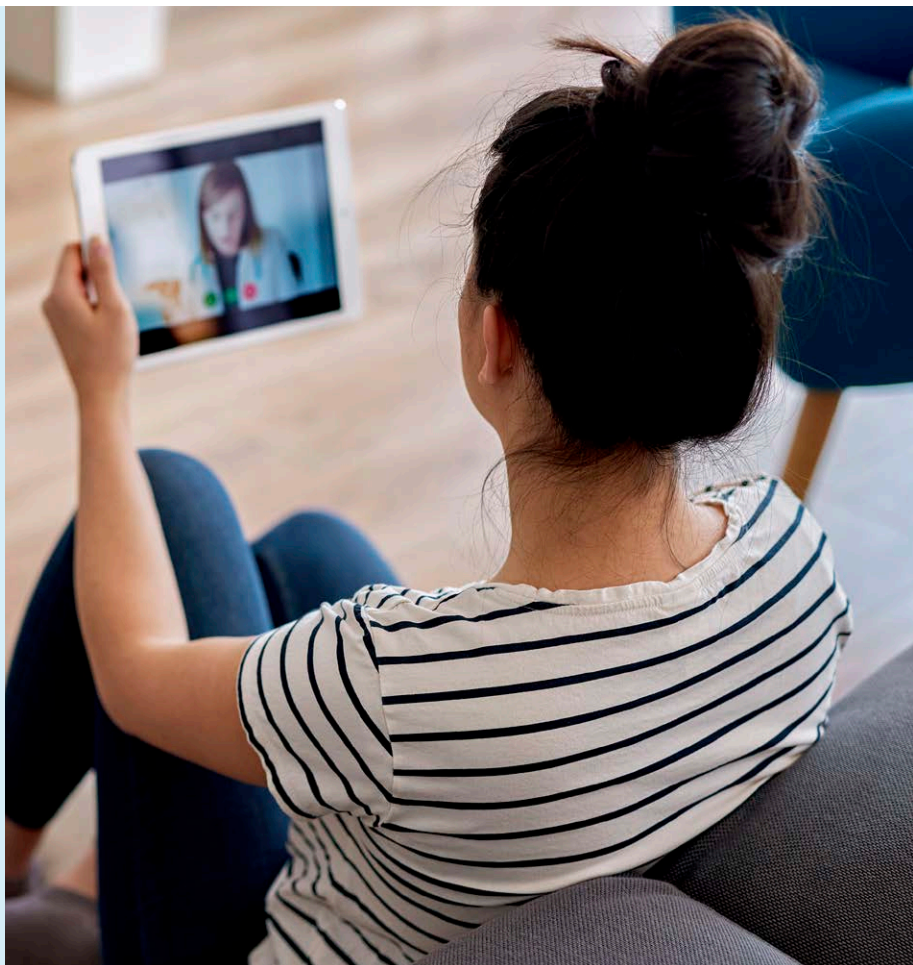


Enter your location and we'll find a teleconsultation provider or medical information service for you.

Via telehealth you can get medical advice, treatment recommendations and access prescriptions (where possible) for non-emergency medical concerns. Teleconsultations can help you treat a wide range of medical conditions such as:

- Cough and colds
- Sore throat
- Earache
- Urinary symptoms
- Diarrhoea
- Indigestion
- Eye infection
- Rash
- Sinus congestion/allergy
- Headache
