PUBLIC PARTICIPATION NOTICE OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION PROCESS FOR THE PROPOSED UPGRADE OF THE DR 1797 ROAD WITHIN THE WESTERN CAPE PROVINCE

Notice is hereby given of the Basic Assessment Process, as well as the General Authorisation Process, for the upgrade of the DR 1797 Road within the Western Cape Province:

- The Basic Assessment process will be undertaken in accordance with the provisions of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998) (NEMA) and the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations 2014, as amended in 2017.
- The General Authorisation (GA) will be conducted in accordance with Section 39 of the National Water Act, 1998 (Act No. 36 of 1998) (NWA).

An Environmental Application has been submitted to the Department of Environmental Affairs and Development Planning (DEA&DP) for the proposed upgrade of the DR 1797 Road in terms of Government Notices 983 and 985 (Listing Notice 1 and 3) of the EIA Regulations. The project will trigger the need for Environmental Authorisation (EA) to be obtained through a Basic Assessment (BA) process. The Competent Authority for the BA process is the WC DEA&DP and the Competent Authority for the GA is the Breede-Gouritz Catchment Management Agency (BGCMA).

Project Location

The proposed project is for the upgrade of the DR 1797 from a gravel to a tarred road. The DR 1797 Road is situated within the Garden Route District Municipality (formerly Eden District Municipality), east of Plettenberg Bay, within the Western Cape Province.

Project Description

The Western Cape Government is conducting periodic maintenance of several roads within the Western Cape Province. As part of this project, the DR 1797 Road will be upgraded. This project entails upgrading the current gravel road to a tarred road, as well as realigning some areas to ensure the road is safe and easy to drive. The culverts which allow drainage around the DR 1797, will be replaced as well as cleaned out to ensure flow is not restricted. There will be one major culvert constructed, which will include raising the road to ensure it is safe for drivers.
