## 1. Site Notice Content

#### PROJECT ANNOUNCEMENT AND AVAILABILITY OF DRAFT BASIC ASSESSMENT REPORT:

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION NOTICE OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION PROCESS FOR THE PROPOSED UPGRADE
OF THE DR 1797 ROAD WITHIN THE WESTERN CAPE PROVINCE

Notice is hereby given of the Basic Assessment (BA) process for the upgrade of the DR 1797 Road within the Western Cape Province: This process will take place in accordance with the provisions of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998) (NEMA) and the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations 2014, as amended 2017.

An Environmental Application has been submitted to the Western Cape Provincial Department of Environmental Affairs and Development Planning (DEA&DP) for the proposed upgrade of the DR 1797 Road in terms of Government Notices 983 and 985 (Listing Notices 1 and 3) of the NEMA EIA Regulations. The project will trigger the need for Environmental Authorisation (EA) to be obtained through a BA process.

#### PROJECT LOCATION

The proposed project is for the upgrade of the DR 1797 Road from a gravel to tarred road. The DR 1797 Road is situated within the Garden Route District Municipality (formally Eden District Municipality), east of Plettenberg Bay, within the Western Cape Province.

#### PROJECT ACTIVITIES

The following listed activities in terms of the EIA Regulations, will be triggered

Listing Notice 1 of 4 December 2014, as amended 7 April 2017, Government Notice No. 983	No. 12	The development of— (i) dams or weirs, where the dam or weir, including infrastructure and water surface area, exceeds 100 square metres; or (ii) infrastructure or structures with a physical footprint of 100 square metres or more; where such development occurs—  (a) within a watercourse; (b) in front of a development setback; or (c) if no development setback exists, within 32 metres of a watercourse, measured from the edge of a watercourse;
	No. 19	The infilling or depositing of any material of more than 10 cubic metres into, or the dredging, excavation, removal or moving of soil, sand, shells, shell grit, pebbles or rock of more than 10 cubic metres from a watercourse;

As part of the BA process, the EIA Regulations require a 30 day Public Participation Process to be followed, during which all registered Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs) have the opportunity to participate in the process.

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

Figure 1: Site notices positions


