

In fact, when labour charges are added, even the simplest problem could land you with a considerable bill.





Electric Vehicles

We understand that the changing technology within motor vehicles can seem complex and confusing. **We** are committed to making sure that all of **our** customers feel comfortable with their **vehicle** warranties and are confident that **we** understand the changing technology and, most importantly, reflect that in **our** products. **We** are pleased to confirm that if **your vehicle** is fitted with any of the following parts, they are covered by **your** warranty.

Electric vehicles

We have added this section to cover the parts that are unique to plug-in hybrids, self-charging hybrids and full electric vehicles.


As well as the high level of cover listed throughout this warranty document, there are a number of unique parts in **your vehicle** that relate to the electric power, and some of the extra items covered under this warranty are

listed below. These items may or may not be fitted to **your vehicle**, depending on the type of electric drive **you** have chosen (for example, full electric, hybrid or self-charging hybrid).

DC/DC converter: This device converts higher-voltage DC power from the traction battery pack to the lower-voltage DC power needed to run **your vehicle's** accessories and recharge the auxiliary battery.

Electric traction motor: Using power from the traction battery pack, this motor drives the vehicle's wheels. Some vehicles use motor generators that both drive the wheels and charge the battery.

Onboard charger: This device takes the incoming AC electricity supplied from the charge port and converts it to DC power for charging the traction battery. It also communicates with the charging equipment

and monitors battery characteristics such as voltage, current, temperature and the level of charge while charging the pack.

Power electronics controller: This unit manages the flow of electrical energy provided by the traction battery, controlling the speed of the electric traction motor and the torque that it produces.

Thermal system (cooling): This system maintains the proper operating temperature range of the engine, electric motor, power electronics, and other parts.

Battery (all-electric auxiliary): In an electric-drive vehicle, the auxiliary battery provides electricity to power the vehicle's accessories.

Traction battery pack: This pack stores electricity for the electric traction motor.

Transmission (electric): The transmission transfers mechanical power from the electric traction motor to drive the wheels.


Electric generator: This generates electricity from the wheels while braking, transferring that energy back to the traction battery pack. Some vehicles use motor generators that both drive the wheels and charge the battery.

Charge port: The charge port allows the **vehicle** to connect to an external power supply in order to charge the traction battery pack.

Battery range anxiety (full electric vehicles only)

If **your** electric **vehicle** runs out of charge, **we** will take **your vehicle, you** and up to five passengers to either the nearest charge point, **your** home address or **your** planned destination, whichever is nearer.

Please note, there is a limit of two call-outs throughout each yearly warranty period.

In the unlikely event that your car breaks down it's good to know that someone will come out to help.

Our Motor Warranty Assistance package eases the inconvenience and discomfort of a breakdown by offering comprehensive cover 24 hours a day, every day of the year.

Stephen James Assistance covers the vehicle, so anyone who is driving the car is covered.

Roadside Assistance

Response and transfer of vehicle, caravan or trailer plus five passengers to the nearest garage

Recovery

Transportation to home address, or journey destination

Home Start

Response at home or within one mile, or transfer for repair to the nearest garage

Accident

Assistance in the event of a road accident and transportation to a local nominated address

Message Service

Two messages to home and office

Puncture Cover

Cover provided in the event of a puncture

Nationwide Recovery

Provides recovery of an immobilised vehicle (including a caravan or trailer which was on tow at the time) and up to a maximum of five people to the nearest garage able to undertake the repair. If this is not possible at the time, you will be transported to your home or your original destination

Territorial Limits means Great Britain, Northern Ireland, The Channel Islands and The Isle of Man.

If your vehicle fails to pass its next MOT test due to a failure of any part listed on a VT30 (MOT Test Failure Form), this optional MOT Test Cover will pay up to **£750** including VAT per MOT test to cover the cost of repair.

Cover includes:

- **Lamps and Reflectors – Lamps (Xenon, HID and LED), reflectors, indicators, bulbs, headlamp levelling and cleaning devices.**
- **Steering – manual and power steering units, drag links, track rod ends.**
- **Suspension – shock absorbers, springs, wishbones, swivel joints, mountings, sub-frames and wheel bearings.**
- **Braking system – Electronic stability control (ESC) components, electronic parking brake, master cylinder, wheel cylinders, calipers, discs/drums, load compensator, ABS modulator/sensors.**
- **Seat belts and Supplementary Restraint System (SRS) – mountings, belts, retractors and buckles, SRS components including airbags, pre-tensioners and limiters.**
- **Body, Structure and General Items – Vehicle structure is covered for corrosion, engine mountings, horn(s), tyre pressure monitoring system (TPMS), windscreen wiper arms and blades, windscreen wiper motor and washer motor.**
- **Fuel and Emissions – Throttle body, air flow meter, EGR valve, catalytic convertor, fuel ECU and DPF sensor.**
