Almost any hearing aid can work with any level of technology, so it's about finding the right hearing aid that works best for you.

Receiver In-Ear (RIE)

Its thin wire creates better cosmetic appeal and leaves the ear canal open for more natural sound and own-voice quality.

Behind the Ear

This larger style accommodates severe to profound hearing loss and has a larger battery for longer life. It's easier to manipulate and works well in theaters and playhouses.

Mic-In-Helix (MIH)

Great for the outdoors, the mic eliminates wind noise and allows for more volume. It has great cosmetic appeal as a custom product for someone with more severe hearing loss.

Custom-Made In-Ear

This style is molded to fit exactly in the ear. It's easier to put in and comfortable. It's small and discreet and easy to use with a phone.
