What are the benefits of the new Horticulture Investment Roadmap(s) and digital dashboard?

- A key benefit for growers and industry stakeholders will be a more flexible approach to investment planning.
- It will be fast and easy to get a snapshot of Australian horticulture priorities across industries, view projects for each industry, and identify opportunities for collaboration.
- There will be no more scrolling through PDFs.
- Users will be able to filter by specific criteria relevant to industry needs.
- Industry objectives, initiatives and projects can be monitored and adjusted to changing conditions.

- Up until September 2026, you can access the Strategic Investment Plan (SIP) PDF reports.
- From late September 2026, investment plan information will be accessed via the Horticulture Investment Roadmap dashboard on the Hort Innovation website.

What is the new SIP called?

- Horticulture Investment Roadmap.
- From July 2026 each industry SIP will be replaced by its new industry Investment Roadmap (i.e. Mango Investment Roadmap).

Why have you renamed the SIPs?

- Annual reviews that reflect current conditions and priorities
- Easy access to information about levy investments via the digital dashboard
- Simplified investment plans
- Easy access to clear insights useful for industry and growers.
