PRODUCT FOR CONTROL OF FALL ARMYWORM IN TURF PRODUCTION**

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows the Permit Holder and any person stipulated below to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

CONDITIONS OF USE

Products to be used:

ACELEPRYN TURF INSECTICIDE (APVMA No. 63085)

Containing: 200 g/L CHLORANTRANILIPROLE as the only active constituent.

ACELEPRYN GR TURF INSECTICIDE (APVMA No. 85185)

Containing: 2 g/kg CHLORANTRANILIPROLE as the only active constituent.

Restrains:

- DO NOT apply when the soil is saturated with water as adequate distribution of the active ingredient vertically in the soil profile cannot be achieved under this condition.
- DO NOT apply more than 2.8 L per hectare per year in broadcast applications in turfgrass (200g/L Chlorantraniliprole) or 280 kg product per hectare per year (2 g/kg Chlorantraniliprole)

Directions for Use:

Turf production	Fall Armyworm (<i>Spodoptera frugiperda</i>)	<u>200g/L product</u> 750 ml/ha <u>200g/kg product</u> 75 kg/ha

Critical Use Comments:

- Regularly scout crops to monitor for eggs and larvae. Treat when pests appear, targeting eggs at hatch or small larvae (prior to third instar stage) before the pest becomes entrenched.
- Follow directions on the registered label.
- Delay of watering (irrigation) or mowing for 24 hours after application may deliver optimum control.
- Refer to the Insecticide Resistance Management (IRM) on the product label to prevent or delay the development of insecticide resistance.
- Dangerous to aquatic invertebrates. Comply with spray drift restraints and no-spray zones on the product label.

Withholding Period:

GRAZING AND STOCKFOOD: DO NOT graze treated turf/lawn or feed turf/lawn clippings from any treated area to poultry or livestock.

Jurisdiction:

All States and Territories, except VIC.

Note: Victoria is not included in this permit, as their Control-of-Use legislation means a permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in that State.

Additional Conditions:

This permit allows for the use of a product in a manner specified on the permit. Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit. Unless otherwise stated, the use of the product must be in accordance with the product label.
