Products to be used:

BANOL TURF AND ORNAMENTAL SYSTEMIC FUNGICIDE (APVMA No. 62826)
PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS
Containing: 600 g/L PROPAMOCARB as the only active constituent.

CAMPBELL PROPLANT FUNGICIDE (APVMA No. 51322)
PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS
Containing: 605 g/L PROPAMOCARB as the only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Disease	Rate
Papaya (<i>Carica papaya</i>) seedlings 1-3 weeks old in nursery situations prior to planting out	Damping off (<i>Pythium</i> spp.)	15 mL/10 L water

Critical Use Comments:

- Apply one application to 1-3 week old seedlings in nursery.
- Apply 2 litres of diluted mixture per square metre of soil.
- Apply as a soil drench using backpack, hand lance sprayer, watering can or equivalent.
- Follow special conditions on the product label.
- Only to be used in nursery situations prior to planting out.
- Ensure drench provides good coverage of soil surrounding each seedling.
- Product is corrosive to metals and solution should be washed out of spray apparatus immediately after use.

Withholding Period:

Not required when used as directed.

Jurisdiction:

NSW, QLD, NT, WA only.

Additional Conditions:

This permit allows for the use of a product in a manner specified on the permit. Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit. Unless otherwise stated, the use of the product must be in accordance with the product label.

The holder of the permit must notify the APVMA of new information, including relevant information in accordance with section 161 of the Schedule to the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Act 1994, in accordance with the obligation imposed by that section.

To Avoid Crop Damage

The sensitivity of the crop to be treated under this permit has not been fully evaluated. It is advisable to only treat a small area to ascertain the reaction before treating the whole crop.
