

MAP OF THE PERMANENT EXHIBITION







But first, here's some key information about the Paris 2024 Olympic Games for the adults accompanying you on this visit:


- 10,500 athletes (50% women and 50% men).
- More than 200 delegations from different countries and an Refugee Olympic team.
- 329 events in over 40 disciplines.
- 95% of the necessary infrastructure is already in place or temporary.
- An Opening Ceremony is scheduled on the River Seine on 26 July.
- The mascots for the Paris 2024 Olympic and Paralympic Games are inspired by the Phrygian cap. This headgear, popularised by the French revolutionaries, is a republican symbol of freedom.




