Creating a Zero Trust Roadmap

Day 1: Zero Trust Strategy Development

Introduction to Zero Trust Architecture

- Understand the evolution from perimeter security to zero trust principles.
- Articulate core ZTA concepts.
- Assess organizational readiness for zero trust adoption.

Zero Trust Frameworks

- Distinguish between NIST, CISA ZTMM, and DoD Zero Trust Reference Architecture.
- Select appropriate frameworks based on organizational context and compliance drivers.
- Understand framework-to-framework trade-offs.

The Five/Seven Pillars of Zero Trust

- Understand zero trust pillars and their interconnections.
- Map zero trust pillars to real-world incidents and vulnerabilities.
- Prioritize pillars based on risk, compliance drivers, and organizational constraints.

Zero Trust Technology Ecosystem

- Understand the major technology categories supporting zero trust.
- Map capabilities to pillar requirements.
- Design vendor-neutral technology architecture within budget and timeline constraints.

Maturity Assessment & Gap Analysis

- Conduct honest maturity assessment using chosen framework.
- Identify capability, process, technology, and skill gaps.
- Benchmark against sector norms and target maturity levels.

Building a Zero Trust Roadmap

- Develop phased 18-month implementation roadmap with realistic sequencing.
- Identify quick wins and foundational initiatives.
- Build in dependencies, resource requirements, and success metrics.

Governance, Risk, & Compliance Integration

- Design governance structure and decision-making framework for zero trust.
- Develop core policies aligned to zero trust principles and compliance frameworks.
- Integrate zero trust into existing compliance narratives.

Executive Communication & Quick Wins

- Build business case for zero trust investment with risk and opportunity narratives.
- Communicate zero trust to executives, auditors, and boards.
- Identify and plan 90-day quick wins that demonstrate momentum.
