- > reduce our greenhouse gas emissions through improvements in the energy and resource efficiency of our premises, business and events-related travel policies and through supply chain engagement
- > work hard in every location to achieve 100% renewable energy across our premises
- > support and progress biodiversity initiatives through volunteering, client work, pro bono and offsetting
- > integrate circular and responsible sourcing principles into our firmwide processes and relevant business functions. Use our buying power to select products and services with appropriate environmental credentials and work with suppliers to reduce negative impacts and decarbonise
- > raise awareness about environmental issues and this policy through networks and direct communication, engage with our key stakeholders including our people, our peers and our clients.
