

The NMMC Mentorship Academy is a model program created by the Mississippi Center for Quality and Workforce. The Academy targets students with interest in nursing or other healthcare careers. Students will be trained and mentored in a state-approved, 80-clock-hour Certified Nursing Assistant program.

The Mentorship Academy will meet at NMMC-Tupelo from **3-4:30 p.m. on Tuesdays for six weeks beginning March 3, 2026** (skipping Spring Break week). The student will also be required to complete a 2-hour shadowing session each of those weeks (to be scheduled after acceptance). The 80-clock-hour Certified Nursing Assistant Program will be held in **June 2026** at ICC's Belden campus, exact dates and times TBA.
