Physician Shadowing Program

The Physician Shadowing Program at North Mississippi Medical Center-Tupelo provides a three-week, immersive, hands-on experience for pre-med students aspiring toward a career in medicine. This program is tailored to students who have completed at least one year of college. Students will engage with physicians and other hospital staff in various specialties, learning about everything from anatomy to bedside mannerisms.

This experience has been designed to better prepare students for medical school, provide insight into what physicians do and why and may help guide students toward a particular specialty. The program also shows the students local practice opportunities.

Each student receives a \$1000 scholarship, a lab coat and other support materials. This program is funded by the Health Care Foundation of North Mississippi through the Dr. P.K. Thomas Endowed Scholarship Fund.

If accepted, applicants must be available for work during the entire 3 week period. Deadline to submit all applications is **April 25, 2025.**

- 1. Written statement expressing why you aspire to become a physician and how shadowing a physician could be beneficial to you; previous experience in health care such as job shadowing, volunteer work, internship, employment, etc.
- 2. Two letters of recommendation from an instructor, manager/supervisor and/ or peers.
- 3. College transcript
