ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

North Mississippi Health Services offers several programs to support nursing students including our summer Mentorship Academy, Nurse Intern/Extern Programs and New Graduate Nurse Residency Program. These programs support RN students by providing immersive, hands-on nursing experience and training as well as a source of income.

Nursing students successfully participating in any of these programs will receive priority consideration for the scholarship. Income earned through program participation does not reduce the amount of scholarship funds received.

This scholarship is available to nursing students and is paid directly to the school on the student's behalf.

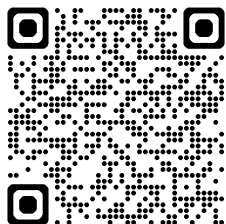


ELIGIBILITY

- Proof of acceptance into a nursing program
- Ability to work in a bedside clinical RN role during the program and post-graduation (e.g. hospital, nursing home).
- US citizen or Green Card holder with social security number and one piece of photo identification
- 18+ years of age

REQUIREMENTS

- Students must be able to work in a bedside RN role during the program and post-graduation (e.g. hospital, nursing home).
- Students must agree to work at NMHS for a minimum of two years after graduating (a signed promissory note is required).
