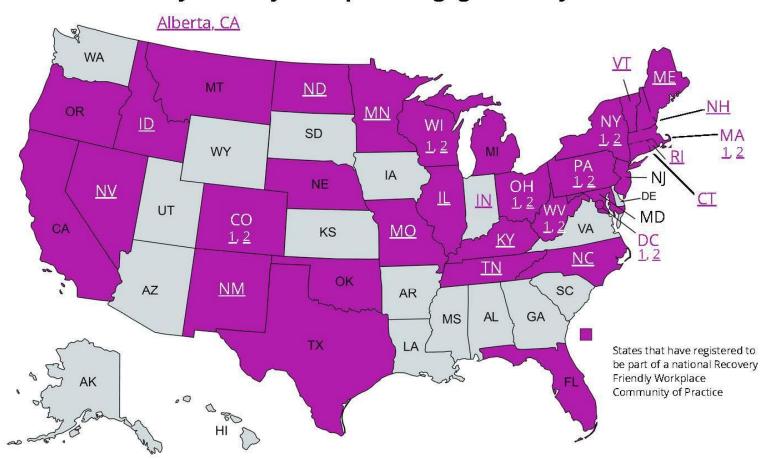

- A café area with a coffee bar and a wide selection of non-alcoholic beverages and healthy food options.
- A meeting space available for recovery meetings, community events, classes, workshops, trainings, and private meetings. Also fun event planning like board game/card nights, karaoke, trivia night, speaker events, movie showings, etc.
- **A kid's corner** available with toys, books, and carpeted area with trusted volunteer/staff to provide childcare during recovery meetings.
- **A computer lab area** with High-Speed Internet to check email, work on resumes, print or copy documents free up to 10 pages.
- **A broadcast studio area** suited to record or live-stream podcasts, interviews, with audience participation capabilities.
- A retail corner with wellness products like books, journals, essential oils, teas, and recovery support tools.
- Full working kitchen to be used to create café menu items as well as hold culinary classes.
