AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO CONSORTIUM AGREEMENT

Updated FEBRUARY 23, 2026

PURPOSE

This Amendment No. 1 ("Amendment") is entered into as of February 23, 2026, between: Michigan State University, College of Agriculture and Natural Resources ("MSU CANR") and Delta College (collectively, the "Parties").

The Parties entered into a Consortium Agreement dated April 9, 2024 (updated April 9, 2024) regarding the Food Processing, Technology & Safety Certificate and Associate in Applied Science programs (the "Agreement").

The Parties wish to correct **Section C, paragraph 1** to accurately reflect Delta College's residency requirement for an associate degree, which is **24 credits** rather than 15 credits.

AMENDMENT

Section C, paragraph 1 of the April 9, 2024 Agreement currently reads:

"Delta College will offer an Associate in Applied Science for those students who wish to add an associate degree to an MSU certificate. Delta College agrees to accept all MSU Certificate coursework in transfer toward the associate degree where the grade is a 2.0 or better. To be awarded an associate degree at Delta College, students must complete all required coursework, with at least 15 credits of coursework at Delta College, and any other program requirements for the associate degree."

Section C, paragraph 1 is hereby amended to read:

"Delta College will offer an Associate in Applied Science for those students who wish to add an associate degree to an MSU certificate. Delta College agrees to accept all MSU Certificate coursework in transfer toward the associate degree where the grade is a 2.0 or better. To be awarded an associate degree at Delta College, students must complete all required coursework,

with at least 24 credits of coursework at Delta College, and any other program requirements for the associate degree."

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Effective Date: This Amendment is effective as of the date of the last signature below.

Ratification: All other terms of the April 9, 2024 Agreement remain in full force and effect. In the event of any conflict between this Amendment and the original Agreement, this Amendment controls.

Authority: Each signatory represents they have authority to bind their institution to this Amendment.
