

**Actions Taken at Recent Meetings**

No meeting March 6th, 2025 (Spring Break)

March 20, 2025

Vice Provost of Undergrad Education shared we are set to launch the new Lansing Cohort program geared towards students who come from the Lansing school district.

Digital Learning Discussion from the Vice Provost of Teaching and Learning Innovation-Marcio Oliveira-he plans to do a deeper dive into the survey conducted last fall and will present findings to our committee at a later date.

Curriculum Requests:

Business, Admission to College (Change): Streamline for engagement. Addressing challenges of belonging as well as addressing formal process. Communication will go to committed students to encourage students to explore different areas of study so that we can ensure they understand early on what degree that they want to pursue. Motion passed with majority.

Business Graduation Requirements, BA (Moratorium): Business Graduation Requirements, BS (New): Working to move to a STEM focused bachelor's degree as the field has continued to become more analytical/quantitative. This is not to change the curriculum but to have a better definition of the already established curriculum.

Motion passed to put BA into moratorium for all Broad Business Degrees by majority.

Motion passed to "create" BS Business degree within Broad by majority.

Engineering, Admission to College (Change): This change is to ensure there is a clear understanding of which programs in the College require Chem151 vs 141 (cleanup). Motion passed with majority vote.

Engineering, Graduation Requirements (Change): Cleanup for undergraduate minors to link to information that is continually updated vs in the description which would need to be continually updated. Motion passed with majority vote.
