Reminders

Faculty Senate meetings are **recorded and streamed**, meaning any member of the university community, media, or broader public can watch them live or later on.

When you join the Zoom meeting, please **rename yourself based on your role**. Faculty senators are “Sen. [Last name].” Students are “Rep. [Last name].” Administrators should use their titles. Those who are not members of the Faculty Senate should rename themselves “NV – [Name]” to indicate they are non-voting participants.

University employees (with limited exceptions) have a **reporting obligation** when they become aware of incidents of relationship violence, stalking, or sexual misconduct that involve a member of the university community (i.e., faculty, staff, or a student) or occur at a university event or on university property.
