Draft Minutes September 30, 2025



A regular meeting of the University Council was held on September 30, 2025, at 3:15pm via Zoom with President Kevin Guskiewicz presiding. The agenda was approved as presented. The minutes of the April 21, 2025, meeting were approved as presented.

#### Remarks

President Kevin Guskiewicz, Provost Laura Lee McIntyre, and Faculty Senate Chairperson Angela Wilson provided remarks to the University Council.

#### **Update from Government Relations**

Congress remains at an impasse on passing a continuing resolution (CR). The Senate is expected to vote again on two proposals (a CR through Nov. 21 and a Democratic alternative through Oct. 31), but both are likely to fail. A one-week CR may be introduced overnight. A government shutdown is therefore very likely.

MSU is coordinating closely with the Big Ten, AAU, APLU, and other associations to advocate in Washington. University leadership is also engaging with federal agencies, state associations, and corporate partners to mitigate risks, protect research funding, and support international students and scholars.

#### Update from Associated Students at Michigan State University (ASMSU)

ASMSU President Kathryn Harding provided an update on the work of the undergraduate student government. This year is especially significant as ASMSU prepares for a spring referendum to renew and increase the \$21-persemester student tax, which funds events, services, and RSO support. To strengthen student engagement, ASMSU is hosting an open forum, launching its Student Allocation Board funding process, and holding fall elections to fill vacant General Assembly seats. Harding highlighted student mental health as the primary issue, noting strong opposition to the proposed absorption of psychiatric services and staff layoffs. A student petition gained more than 1,400 signatures, and ASMSU passed a resolution affirming support for CAPS in its current form under the leadership of Dr. Swapna Hingwe. She emphasized that any decisions about student mental health services must be transparent, consultative, and aligned with MSU's commitment to well-being under the

Okanagan Charter. In addition, ASMSU is working with the "One Team, One Health" initiative to ensure student perspectives are considered in planning for health and medical education. Harding closed by reaffirming ASMSU's commitment to amplifying student voices and advocating for student-centered decisions throughout the year.
