LEADERSHIP LABS



BRANCH BRIEF

This month, cadets participated in a Branch Brief lab where representatives from multiple Military Occupational Specialties from the Michigan National Guard shared insights about several fields such as military police, infantry, signal, med services, intelligence, aviation, logistics and field artillery. Cadets learned about day-to-day responsibilities, career paths, and opportunities within each branch, helping them better understand their options as future Army officers.



LAND NAVIGATION

Cadets conducted land navigation, strengthening their map reading, point plotting, and terrain navigation skills. The MS3s continued to build their confidence and readiness to ensure success at CST. The lab gave cadets valuable hands-on experience to apply their skills in the field.



ROUND ROBIN

MSI and MSII cadets participated in a round robin lab where they practiced rappelling and learned to assemble and disassemble the M4 rifle. MSIII cadets were tested on several warrior skills. This consisted of M240B and M249 firing procedures, TCCC and MEDEVAC, and land navigation.
