
## **Contextual Navigation**


Display a side navigation in the right column of a two-column component.

## **Event Tile Auto Cycle**

Display an event automatically from a list of events based on "Put Up" date/time and out based on "Take Down" date/time.

This component does not require a container but can be used in a Grid component.

Display one event – content is static (i.e., not swapped out automatically). Component display size can be large or small.

## **Grid Component**

A container for 1 to 6 page components, displayed in table fashion (no borders or spacing between cells). A Grid property controls the number and layout of the cells (tiles).

Select a grid type:

XLarge; 2 Medium; 3 Tall; 3 Medium; 1 Tall 4 Small; 4 Small 1 Tall; 1 Large 2 Small; 2 Small 1 Large; 1 Large 1 Tall; 1 Tall 1 Large; 6 Small

Can use these components: Ad-Coming Soon, Box CTA, Box CTA Social, Event Tile Auto Cycle, Event Tile Constant, Media, Rich Text, Social Feed, Story, Text Fact




## Hero Banner

A large banner image or video (full page width), placed prominently at the top of the page, that serves as the background for the masthead. Text is used as the page title.


Image size can be regular (default) or small. Optional CTA (link or video) can be specified.

## **Text Facts**

Display one or more predefined infographic Facts in a tiled (grid) layout. Optional image can be placed on right or left side.

This component requires a grid, either the Grid component or the Text Facts Grid component. Facts must be created before using the Text Fact component. Facts are stored in Global Components node or site-level Components node.

Each grid cell is assigned a Type:

- Image + 1 column of facts
- Image + 2 columns of facts
- Image + 4 columns of facts

• No image, 1-4 facts



## **Text Facts Grid**

A container for Text Facts components, displayed in table fashion (no borders or spacing between cells).

This component is created first, then Text Facts components are added to it. A Grid property controls the number and layout of the cells (tiles).


## Two-Column Container in Tabs

A container inside a Tabs panel that splits the tabbed content into two columns.

Only certain components can be placed in right and left columns.

## Two-column Grid 66-33

A container that splits the body of a page into two columns of content.

This component is created first, then other components are added to it. Multiple components can be placed in each column, but only certain components are allowed.

The right column often contains the Contextual Navigation component.

To add a Social Share above the column: select the Social Share component and wait for "Social" to appear in area, then it is ready. No other action required.
