

How it works.

- Host College for each program one program
- Partner colleges "own" program and issue degree or certificate
- Partner colleges enroll based on local workforce demand
- All students' complete theory in an online learning community
- Lab and work-based learning arranged in home community
- Graduates fill local job openings
- Program courses run through the Collaborative
- Partners share all expenses and revenue
- · Programs can expand and contract based on workforce demand
