

First Aid, CPR, and Blood-Borne Pathogen Training

All instructors of activity courses (graduate assistants and faculty members) are required to maintain current First Aid and CPR certification. A copy of the certification cards must be on file in Room 134 IM Circle prior to the first day of classes. A renewal/challenge class will be provided during the fall teaching assistant orientation. Teaching assistants and faculty members who are assigned mid-year to teach activity courses must make their own arrangements to obtain these certificates.

CPR masks will be provided at each teaching station. Instructors may also provide their own personal masks.

All instructors of activity courses are required to complete blood-borne pathogen training prior to the first day of classes. This training is provided during the fall teaching assistant orientation. Teaching assistants and faculty members who are assigned mid-year to teach activity courses may arrange for training through the Biological Safety Office, 355-0153. A review copy of the Exposure Control Plan from the Office of Radiation, Chemical, and Biological Safety (ORCBS) is available in Room 134 IM Circle upon request.
