## NIH UPDATES

Per NIH notice <u>NOT-OD-25-085</u>, the Executive Level II salary cap rate increased to \$225,700. The salary cap rate for AY faculty is \$169,275, and the summer salary cap rate is \$56,425.

The implementation of Common Forms for Biographical Sketch and Other Support, scheduled for May 25, 2025, has been <u>delayed</u>. At this time, please use the current the NIH <u>Biosketch</u> and <u>Other Support</u> format pages for applications, Just-in-Time (JIT) and RPPRs.

FORMS-I updates released March 2025:

- OMB number on the PHS forms has been updated to 0925-0001 and 0925-0770 and will expire 01/31/2027.
- PHS 398 Research Training Program Plan removed the required attachment, 'The Recruitment Plan to Enhance Diversity'.
- Description of Candidate's Contribution to Program Goals in the PHS 398 Career Development Supplemental Form and the PHS Fellowship Supplemental Form is no longer required.

#### **GRANT WRITING BOOTCAMP**

Dr. Anna Moore, the Associate Dean for Research Development, created a Grant Writing Bootcamp, a program developed to assist faculty, post-doctoral fellows, and graduate students with the skills and knowledge to write successful grants. The program will be available once per year and contains 7 in-person sessions. Sessions include information regarding the pre-award administrative process, science documents, resubmission and renewals, post-award administration, grant review, and a Q&A session with MSU faculty that have had success with grant applications and funding.
