## PROPERLY CITING GRANTS

NIH reminds investigators that citing an award in a publication is only required when the grant directly supported the research. Researchers may oversite award unintentionally, leading to confusion. NIH notes issues with overciting such as questions of human subjects research violation for grants not related to the publication. Properly citing is vital so as to ensure funding is attributed correctly. NIH guidance is <u>available</u> if you have questions on citations.

#### ALLOWABLE COSTS FOR HUMAN SUBJECTS RESEARCH

Are you writing a grant that involves research participants? Have you had a funded project and encountered barriers that allowed your research subjects to participate? If so, your grant may be eligible to budget for costs to assist participants and improve participation. NIH recently created a resource that outlines allowable costs with participant inclusion activities. Some costs include are childcare, incentives, meals, and patient care.
