NIH EXTENDED ADMIN SUPPLEMENT EXPIRATION DATE

In NOT-OD-03-128, NIH has extended the expiration date for PA-21-071, 'Research Supplements to Promote Diversity in Health-Related Research (Clinical Trial Not Allowed),' to June 30, 2023. If you plan on taking advantage of this extension, please submit a Proposal Intake Form and a HCRS Pre-Award team member will be happy to assist you.

MSU F&A POLICY

MSU's newly negotiated Facilities and Administrative (F&A) rates are now effective on July 1, 2023 - June 30, 2027. The Research rate is 57%, Other Sponsored Activities is 37% and Off Campus rate is 26%. Any proposals or awards with a start date after July 1 will use these new rates. NIH REVISED POST SUBMISSION MATERIALS POLICY

Due to the Public Health Emergency, NIH revised the postsubmission policy that allowed one page of preliminary data to be submitted. As of May 25, 2023, the exception no longer applies. NOT-OD-23-106 now states that one page preliminary data can be submitted with NIH, AHRQ and NIOSH grant applications for New and Resubmission R01, R21, or R03. Renewals and Competitive Revisions will not accept preliminary data as a post submission materials.

NIH DATA MANAGEMENT SHARING POLICY

As a reminder, NIH's Policy for Data Management and Sharing went into effect on January 25, 2023. This policy requires researchers to prospectively plan for how scientific data will be preserved and shared. Researchers are required to submit a Data Management and Sharing Plan with each proposal and to implement the approved plan if funded. Plans should explain

how scientific data will be managed and describe which scientific data and accompanying metadata will be shared in common repositories. This requirement applies to all NIH-funded research that directly results in the generation of scientific data, regardless of funding level or mechanism.
