

Henry Ford + MSU Neuroscience Research Symposium: Poster Presentation Guidelines

All are welcome to submit a poster, either broadly overviewing their research, clinical, education program, and/or, on specific projects.

This includes researchers, clinicians, trainees, health care professionals, and others with an interest in neuroscience research from Michigan State University and Henry Ford Health.

For a poster to be considered to present at the 2nd Annual Henry Ford + MSU Neuroscience Research Symposium, the following requirements must be met.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

1. Title, Authors, Affiliations, and Narrative:
 - Provide the poster **title, author names, institutional affiliations for all authors**, and a **<500-word abstract** describing your poster.
 - Ensure your **title is clear, engaging, and descriptive**, keeping in mind that attendees will come from diverse disciplines.
2. Author Attendance:
 - At least **one author must be present** during the designated poster session to discuss the research and answer questions.

POSTER DISPLAY & LOGISTICS

1. **Printing & Setup:** Presenters are responsible for printing, setting up, and removing their posters on the day of the session.
2. **Materials Provided:** Poster boards, push pins, and other relevant supplies will be available at the venue.
3. **Size Requirements:** Posters must not exceed 48 inches width x 36 inches height. Larger posters may hang over the board.

SUBMISSION DEADLINE

All poster submissions (title, author list with affiliations, and abstract) must be received by Monday, September 28.
