MSU faculty members whose research involves judicial decisions, legislation, or administrative regulations are eligible to become Law College faculty affiliates.

Faculty affiliates are interested in engaging intellectually with the Law College by attending symposia, speakers, or other public events at the College; presenting research at the College; and informing the College of events in your college that our faculty and students may find interesting.

To the extent possible, faculty affiliates commit to submitting at least one paper every other year to the Law College for addition to the College's series on the SSRN-Legal Scholarship Network and to the College's institutional repository on Digital Commons.

The Law College will publish a list of affiliated faculty (including a photo, short bio, and link to your faculty profile) on the College website. The College will encourage research collaboration between full-time College faculty and faculty affiliates.
