Potential scholars submit a proposal for a **new research project** aligned with MIRACLE's goals and identify which mentor(s) they would like to work with.

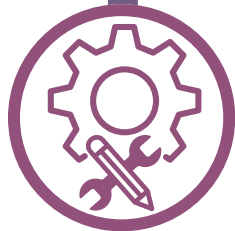


Candidates are rated on:

- ability to carry out the project
- whether the program would give them **career opportunities** they would not otherwise have,
- the project's potential for positive **community impact** and contribution to scientific research



Selected scholars are paired with at least two MIRACLE mentors, one with an **academic** background and one of our **community partners**.



Scholars must work closely their MIRACLE mentor(s) to identify training needs, gain **hands-on research skills**, and complete their proposed project.
