Checkpoint 1: Getting Started

All new undergraduate students will review and complete the following items prior to advising and enrollment: submit the Access & Technology survey, the Math Placement Assessment, and the Language Placement Assessments. Links to these items will be included in the NSO Newsletter sent via email.

Checkpoint 2: January 2026 NSO D2L Course

Starting November 7, all new students are required to complete our virtual January 2026 NSO Experience course in Desire2Learn (D2L). This interactive online course will help students learn more about MSU while identifying key resources prior to the beginning of the semester. The deadline to complete this course and ensure spring advising and enrollment is December 18, 2025.

Checkpoint 3: Advising & Enrollment

After completing the January 2026 NSO Experience course, students will be referred to their advisor/College for next steps regarding their academic advising appointment, which will take place between January 6 and January 8, 2026. Students will be able to enroll for spring semester courses after meeting with their Academic Advisor.
