Subject: Special Liquor License Applications to the Michigan Liquor Control Commission

RESOLUTION:

BE IT RESOLVED that the Trustee Policy Committee recommends to the Board of Trustees that it confirm the authorization of the Secretary of the Board of Trustees to submit applications to the Michigan Liquor Control Commission for the issuance of special liquor licenses for the sale of alcoholic liquor at events on lands governed by the Board of Trustees.

BACKGROUND:

The Michigan Liquor Control Code permits the University to apply for up to twelve special licenses per year for the sale of alcoholic liquor at events on University property not covered by the University's liquor license. The Michigan Liquor Control Commission ("MLCC") requires that a board resolution authorizing the application accompany the application paperwork. The Secretary of the Board of Trustees has historically submitted applications for special liquor licenses pursuant to Article 11 of the Board's Bylaws and corresponding delegations of signature authority. This new resolution will codify more clearly for the benefit of the MLCC the Board's longstanding authorization for the Secretary of the Board of Trustees to submit applications for special liquor licenses on behalf of the University.



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
