BACKGROUND

Program Need:

The Men's and Women's intercollegiate basketball programs have had extraordinary success, including 28 Men's and 14 Women's NCAA tournament appearances, 8 Men's and 1 Women's Final Four appearances, and the 1979 and 1999 Men's National Championships. The coaches' offices and meeting rooms no longer meet expectations for programs of this caliber and are in need of functional, technological, and cosmetic upgrades.

General Description of the Project:

This project is anticipated to include upgrades to both the men's and women's basketball coaching offices including furniture, finishes and displays.

The Berkowitz Basketball Complex is located on Birch Road between West Shaw Lane and Kalamazoo Street in the athletic and recreation district. The location of this project is consistent with the Campus Master Plan.

Based on an assessment of the factors stated in the Project Planning and Approval process concerning Project Labor Agreements (PLA), the Vice President for Strategic Infrastructure Planning and Facilities has determined that a PLA would not be required for this project.

Communication Plan:

During the planning phase, the campus community will be given opportunities to provide feedback on the project as it is being designed. Input from the project planning team will be solicited during the design phase.

Preliminary Project Cost Information:

Based on cost experience for similar projects and current pricing information, the preliminary project cost estimate is \$3,000,000. This estimate may change as planning progresses and the project scope is further defined.

The source of funds for the project is expected to be gifts to Intercollegiate Athletics.
