Mercury Insurance adopts wildfire risk score solution from XyloPlan and Milliman

With the rise of faster, more destructive wildfires—especially in the wildland-urban interface—insurers are seeking tools that reflect how fire truly behaves. "Insurers and communities need a common operating picture grounded in how fire really moves— especially in the wildland-urban interface," said Dave Winnacker, Co-Founder of XyloPlan and former fire chief. "This collaboration helps translate decades of on-the-ground fire service experience into operational intelligence that supports underwriting decisions, strengthens community resilience, and empowers smarter investments in mitigation."

Milliman's PinPoint API serves as the delivery mechanism, integrating XyloPlan's scores along with a suite of geospatial indicators, such as local topography, vegetation characteristics, and structure density information, into Mercury's existing workflow.

"Carriers need access to granular, forward-looking risk tools that that capture both structure- and community-level measures of risk," said Garrett Bradford, Principal & GIS Consultant at Milliman. "By integrating XyloPlan's dynamic wildfire risk scores into the PinPoint platform, we're helping insurers like Mercury make more confident, data-driven decisions in the face of increasing wildfire volatility."
