26/06/2025	General community	Construction works are blocking the shared footpath between Darling Harbour bridge and the Maritime Museum – request that Mirvac either install a temporary cycle path using kerb ramps and traffic cones on the adjacent road or reposition barriers to widen the path.	<p>Mirvac confirmed the current works on the shared path are being undertaken on behalf of Jemena Gas as part of authority-required infrastructure upgrades. These works are on land owned by Property NSW (not the City of Sydney), and Mirvac has obtained all required approvals from PMNSW and is operating in accordance with their guidelines for hoarding and pedestrian access.</p> <p>The blue hoarding in provided photos relates to separate works by the Australian National Maritime Museum and is unrelated to the Harbourside Redevelopment.</p>	Closed
